1. GEOGRAPHICAL CHARACTERISTICS, CLIMATE AND ENVIRONMENT

The Kyrgyz Republic is located in the north-east of the Central Asia. The country is bounded on the north by Kazakhstan, the south-west by Uzbekistan, the south by Tajikistan, on the east and south-east by China. The total length of boundaries of Kyrgyzstan is 4,5 thsd. km, and its territory is 199,9 thsd. km².

Kyrgyzstan is a mountainous country. Almost 90% of the total territory is located higher than 1 500 meters above sea level.

As of January 1, 2022, the number of resident population of the country has made up 6,7 million people. The average population density is 34 people per square kilometer.

The capital city of the country is Bishkek with a population 1,1 million people.

Big cities: Osh (333,6 thousand people), Djalal-Abad (125,5 thousand people), Karakol (85,6 thousand people), Tokmok (71,6 thousand people), Uzgen (64,0 thousand people).

The largest oblast in the area is Naryn (45,2 thousand sq. km).

The most densely populated oblasts are Osh and Chui (49 people per 1 sq. km).

Currently, the system of administrative and territorial structure of the republic includes 7 oblasts (regions) and 2 cities of republican level, 40 administrative districts, 32 cities, 9 urban-type settlements, 3 villages and 452 aйл aimaks (village community).

There are more than 3,500 thousand rivers and rivulets and 1 923 lakes in the republic. There are 44 deposits of underground fresh and mineral waters.

The climate of the country is sharply continental, summer in the cities is rather hot, and relatively cool in the mountains. Winters are cold and snowy, especially in the highlands. The average air temperature in summer in Kyrgyzstan is +27°C, the average minimum temperature is +16°C and the average maximum temperature is kept at +33°C. In winter, air temperature is on average +1°C, the average minimum temperature is -12°C, and the average maximum temperature is kept at + 10°C.

2. PUBLIC AUTHORITIES AND MANAGEMENT, MAIN SOCIO-ECONOMIC INDICATORS

The Kyrgyz Republic (Kyrgyzstan) is an independent, sovereign, democratic, unitary, secular and social State governed by the rule of law. State authority is based on the principle of the separation of legislative, executive and judicial power.

The President is the Head of the State and executive power and the highest official. The President is elected by the citizens of the Kyrgyz Republic for a term of five years.

The Jogorku Kenesh - the Parliament of the Kyrgyz Republic - is the highest representative body exercising legislative power and oversight functions within the limits of its competence

Executive power in the Kyrgyz Republic is exercised by the President.

The structure and composition of the Cabinet of Ministers is set out by the President.

The Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers is the head of the Presidential Administration.

The judicial system of the Kyrgyz Republic is established by the Constitution and laws, and consists of the Constitutional Court, the Supreme Court, and local courts.

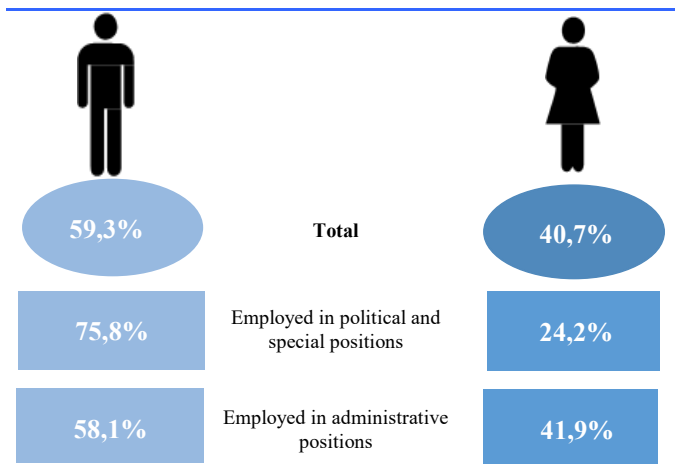

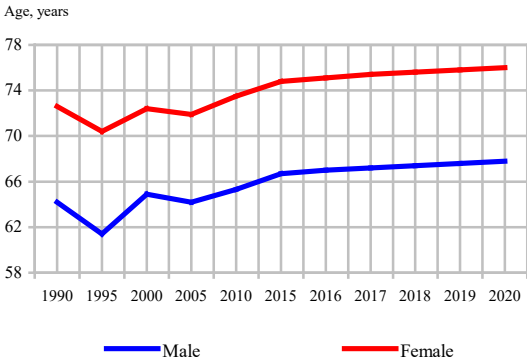

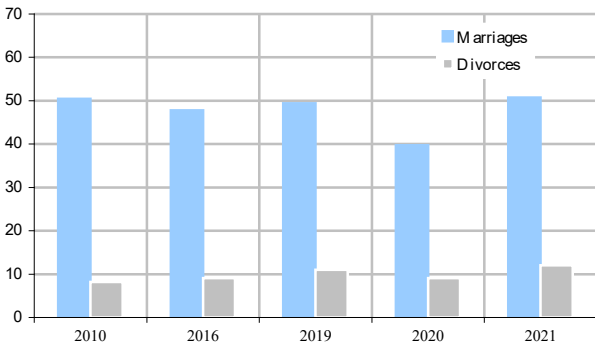

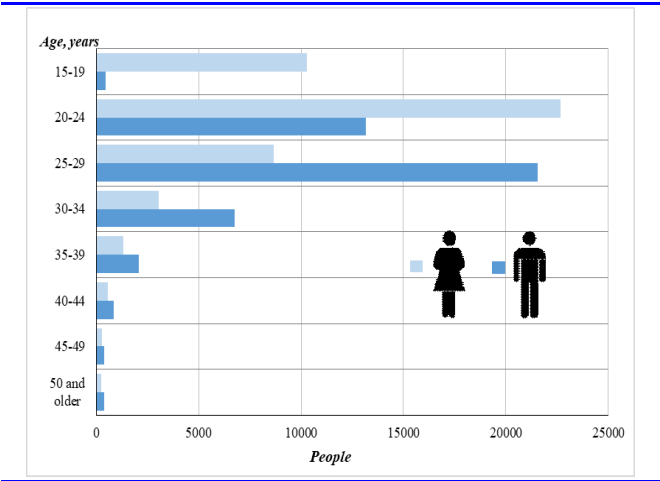
Life expectancy at birth

Number of first marriages by age group in 2021

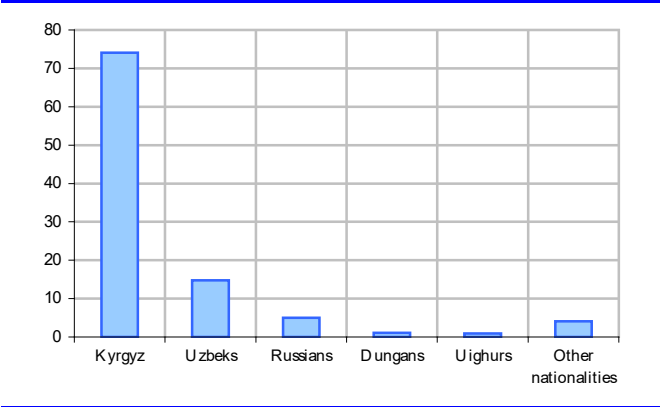

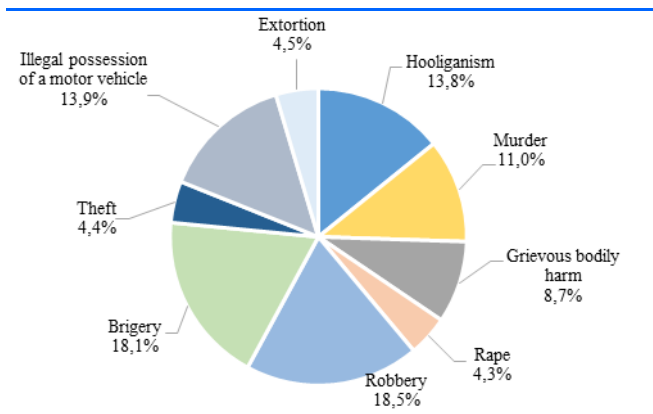

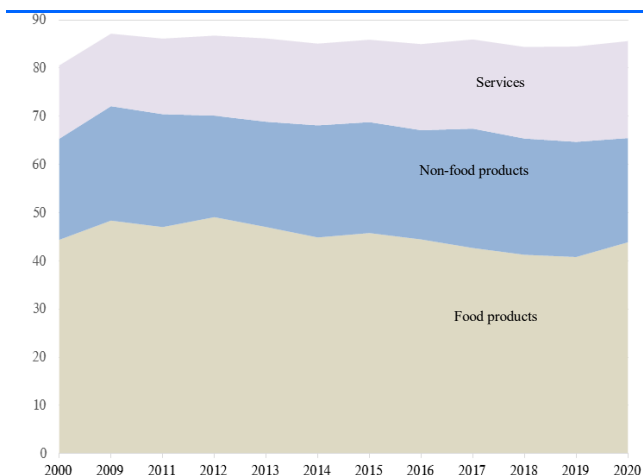

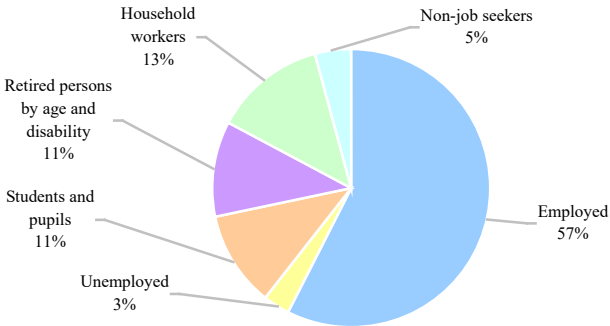
In 2020, 1 million 678 thousand people lived below the poverty line, about 74 percent of which were residents of rural settlements.

People aged 15 and over who are considered to be employed and unemployed during the review period (survey week) belong to the labor force. Employed people are people who performed any activity (at least one hour per week) during the survey week related to the production of goods or the provision of service for payment or profit.

Students and pupils, retirees by age and disability, people not looking for work or housekeeping, are not considered to be employed and unemployed, are persons who are not part of the workforce

In 2020, the labor force amounted to 60% people are not included in the labor force - 40%.

Employed population by type of economic activity in 2020¹

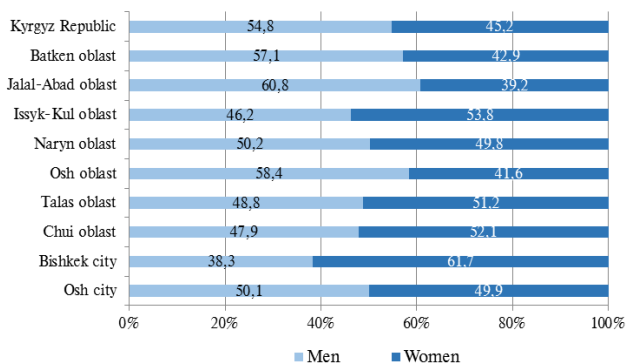

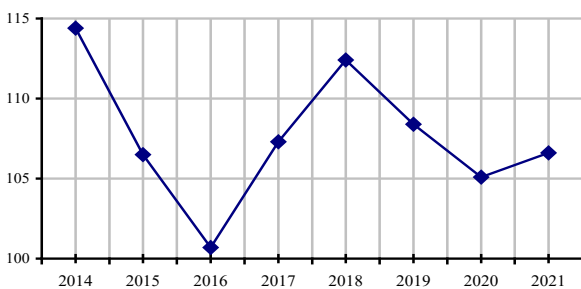

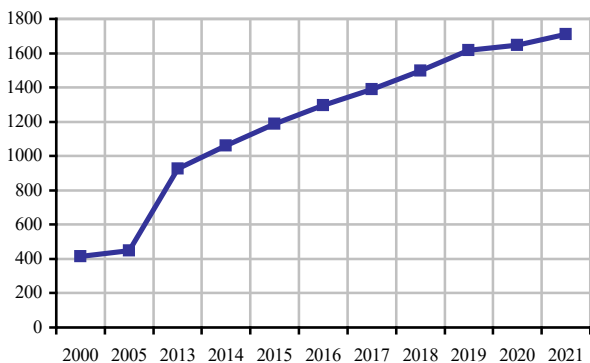

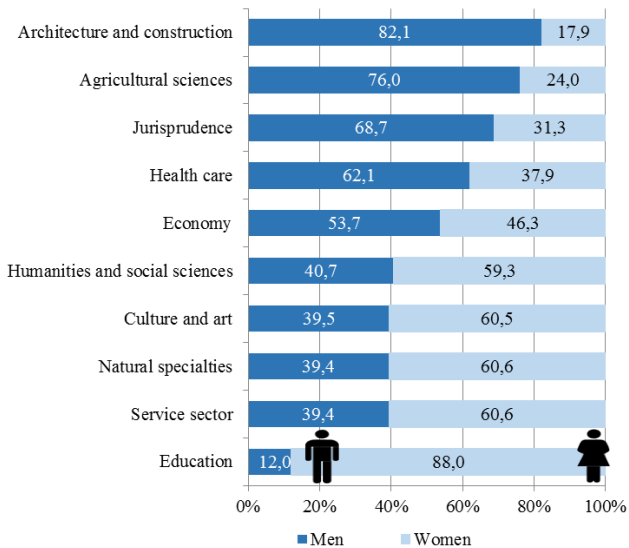

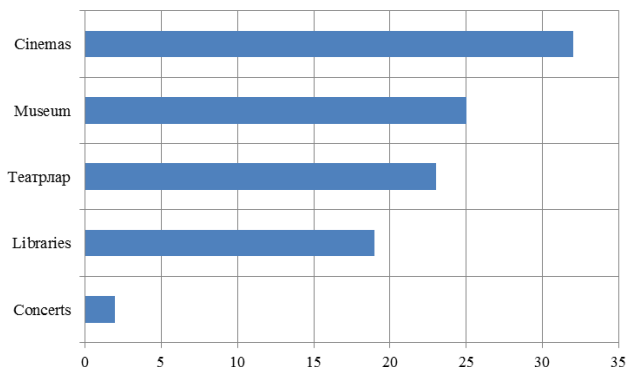

9. TOURISM

In 2021, 419 recreation facilities and tourism organizations received and serviced tourists, of which 155 specialized accommodation facilities, 185 hotels and similar accommodation facilities, 8 natural parks and reserves, 39 other tourist sites, 32 travel agencies and tour operators and excursions bureaus. In addition, 1,449 guest houses provided reception and service for tourists.

The number of tourists in 2021 made up 1.3 mln. people, of which more than 70% were in Issyk-Kul oblast.

In 2021 2.3 thousand citizens of Kyrgyzstan and 0.9 thousand people traveling in Kyrgyzstan were sent to other countries through travel companies, of which 0.7 thousand people were citizens of other countries.

According to data of State Border Service of the Kyrgyz Republic, the number of arrivals of foreign citizens (border crossings by country of citizenship) in 2021 exceeded 3 mln. people, that is more in 1.5 times in comparison with 2020.

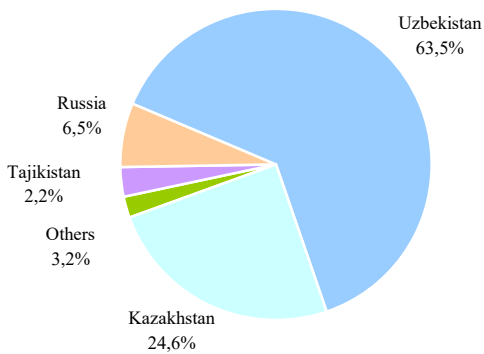

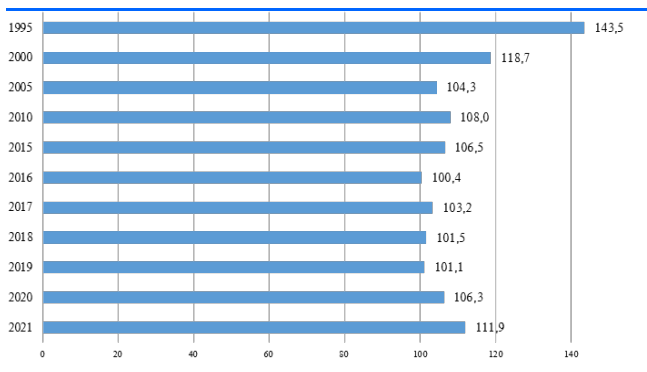

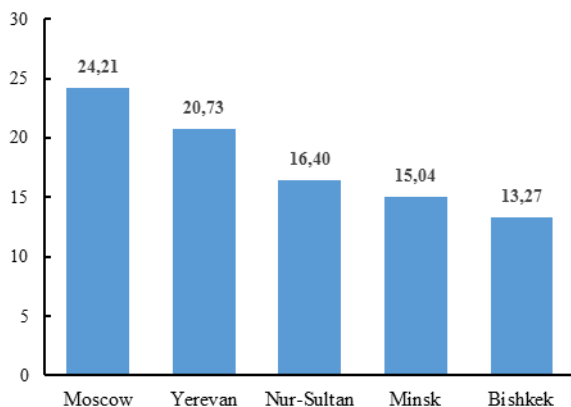
Consumer price index

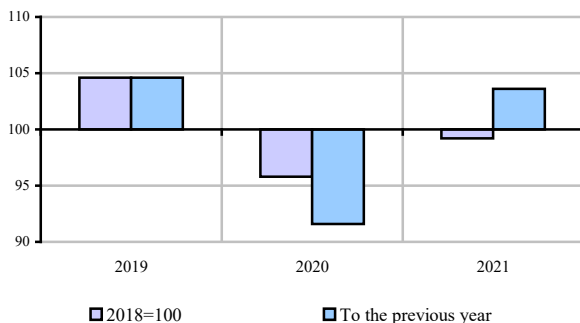

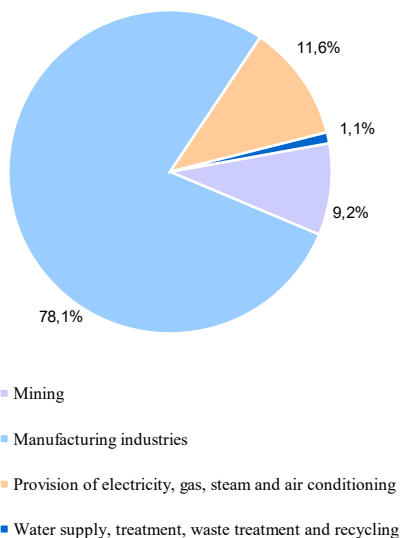

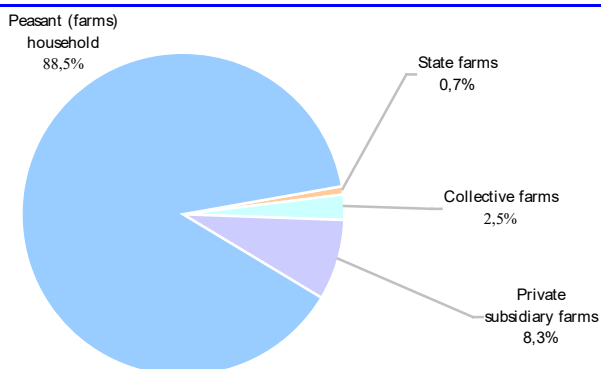
Structure of industrial products in 2021

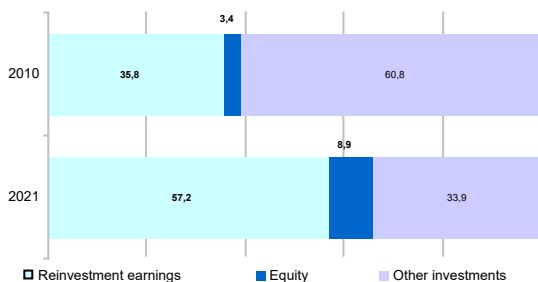

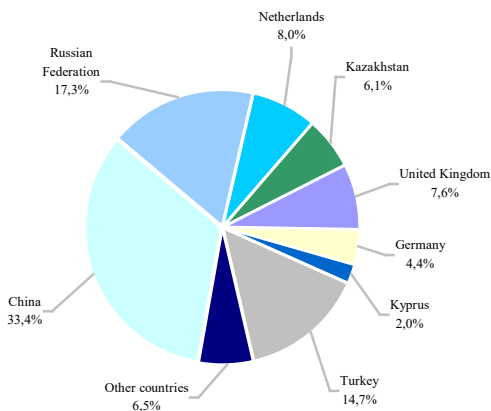
Foreign direct investment structure

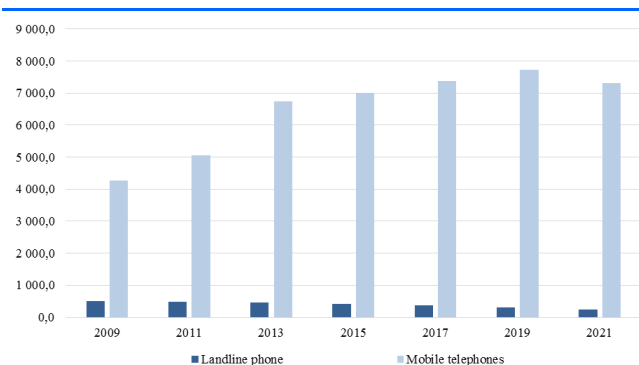

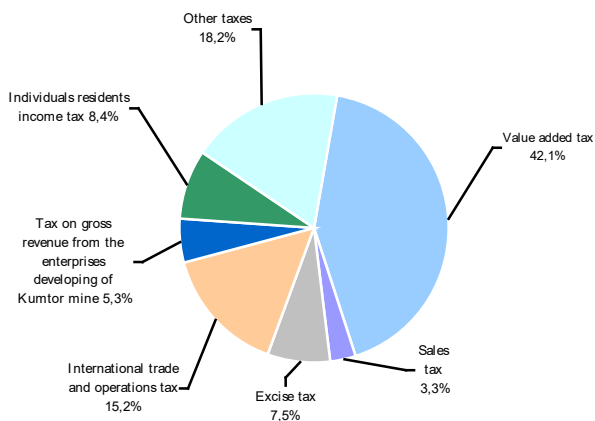

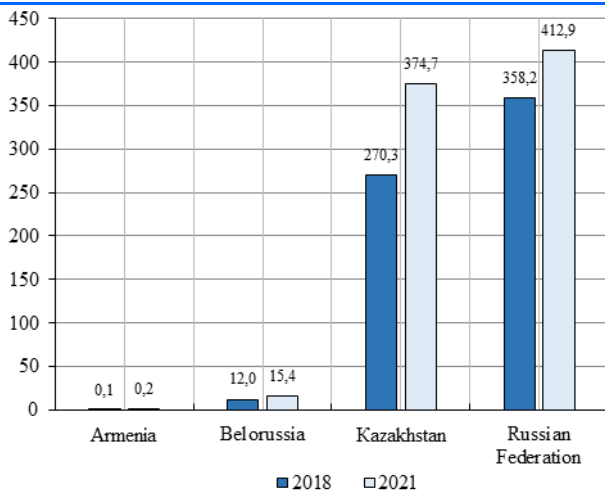
