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This brief statistical handbook contains information on social and economic situation of the Kyrgyz Republic for 2015 in comparison with previous years. Some data for 2015 are preliminary.

Data are given in accordance with the new edition of the State Classification "Economic Activity" (version 3) and in 2015 for some cases are preliminary.

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Geographical characteristics

The Kyrgyz Republic is located in the north-east of the Central Asia. The country is bounded on the north by Kazakhstan, the southwest by Uzbekistan, the south by Tajikistan, on the east and south-east by China. The total length of boundaries of Kyrgyzstan is 4,5 thsd. km, and its territory is 199,9 thsd. km².

Kyrgyzstan is a mountainous country. Almost 90% of the total territory is located higher than 1500 meters above sea level.

As of January 1, 2016, the number of resident population of the country has made up 6,0 million people. The average population density is 30 people per square kilometer.

The capital of the country is Bishkek city with population of more than 900 thsd. people.

There are about 30 thsd. revers and 1923 lakes.

The climate is characterized as sharp continental with cold winter and hot summer and strongly depends on the altitude above sea level. Rainfall is mainly concentrated in autumn, winter and spring, while summer usually is dry.

Administrative and territorial division

At present, the administrative and territorial division of the Republic consists of 7 oblasts (regions) and 2 cities of national level, 40 administrative rayons (districts), 31 towns, 9 urban settlements, 3 villages and 453 aiyl aimak (village community).

The capital of the Kyrgyz Republic is Bishkek city (958,5 thsd. people).

Big cities and towns are OIII city (275,7 thsd.), Djalal-Abad town (111,1 thsd.), Karakol town (74,1 thsd.), Tokmok town (60,4 thsd.), Uzgen (56,1 thsd.).

The largest oblast (region) by area (territory) is Naryn oblast (45,2 thsd. km²).

The most densely populated oblast (region) are Osh and Chui oblastes (43-44 people per 1 km²).




Sex and age structure of population





(per 10 000 population, people)









(as a % to December of the previous year)







Output of main types of industrial products





(as a % to the previous year)










